MADISON MINUTE

After dropping a one-goal contest with Green Bay last weekend, Madison hits the road to face off against the league leading Fargo Force this weekend. The Capitols enter the weekend with a record of 15-9-4-2 on the season.

Austin Burnevik is set to return to the Capitols lineup after missing last Saturday's game due to his participation in the 2024 Chipotle All-American Game. Tied for the league's lead in goals, Madison's forward depth is now back to a full fifteen for the first time since early December.

This weekend's contests are projected to be low scoring affairs as the two teams give up the least amount of goals in the league this season. The goaltending matchup is also intriguing as Fargo and Madison sport the top three goaltenders in goals against average this season. Although he picked up a loss in his last two outings, Carsen Musser has allowed three or less goals in 75% of his outings in his tenure with the Capitols.

Matchup history between these two teams dates back to October 3, 2014, when the Capitols traveled to Fargo in the franchise's third and fourth games since returning to the league the week prior. All time, Madison is 1-8-1-3 against Fargo this season.

MADISON MINUTE

Madison last traveled to Scheels Arena in November of 2019 for a two game series against Fargo. The Force completed a sweep over Madison with the Capitols picking up one point in the two-game-trip to the league's lone North Dakota inhabitant. The Capitols are 0-6-1-1 on the road against Fargo all time.

The most recent contest between the two sides resulted in a Force 8-1 win over Madison in last season's Fall Classic. Only four players on the Madison bench that night are on the team's active roster entering the weekend. On the other side, six players that suited up for the Force in that contest remain on their roster.

Not dressing for the Force in that game but rather for the Capitols was Peter Cisar, who will be facing off against his former squad for the first time since being traded in September. Cisar played in 44 games with Madison last season registering fifteen points. This season the forward has sixteen points in 25 games and made his home country's, Slovakia, World Junior Championship roster.

James Hong had his league long point streak snapped on Saturday night as the Capitols fell 1-0 to the Green Bay Gamblers. Hong's streak came in at thirteen games before being snapped, which is one higher than Juraj Pekarcik in Dubuque's active twelve-game point streak.

It was a quiet week news wise in Madison after two players, Chris Delaney and Jack Henry have committed to division one universities since the turn of the new year. The Capitols have also added Diego Johnson to the active roster since the turn of the year, which has been the only roster move of 2024 for the team.

The Capitols enter play this weekend in sole possession of fifth place in the Eastern Conference. Madison sits two points back of fourth, four back of third, six back of second, and twelve points back of first placed Dubuque. The trip to Fargo kickstarts a five-game stretch of contests against Western Conference foes. Prior to this stretch of games, Madison had only played two games against the Western Conference in their last fifteen games.

BIOGRAPHY

Andy Brandt was announced as the Head Coach and General Manager on May 1, 2023. Brandt, a native of Wausau, Wisconsin, comes to the Capitols after serving as an assistant coach for his alma mater, the University of Wisconsin, during the 2022-23 season. Brandt played with the Badgers for four seasons from 2003-2007 playing in 130 games over that time. Among those 130 games with the Badgers was the 2006 National Championship game where the Badgers captured the program's sixth title.

Following his time playing at Wisconsin, Brandt went onto a six-year playing career in the ECHL and the American Hockey League, which came to an end after the 2012-13 season. He spent the final season of his playing career serving as captain for the Gwinnett Gladiators in the ECHL playing in all 72 games. Brandt's time in Gwinnett was not finished at the conclusion of the 2012-13 season as he made his way behind the bench as an assistant coach on the team the next season.

Brandt served as an assistant coach for two seasons for Gwinnett before the team rebranded to the Atlanta Gladiators prior to the start of the 2015-16 season. The rebranded team had a new role for Brandt as he became the team's Head Coach and General Manager. After two seasons in that role, Brandt moved back home to Wisconsin to become the Associate Head Coach of St. Norbert College. Brandt spent five seasons with St. Norbert College before taking his most recent position with Wisconsin.
